AUGUST PEWS NEWS

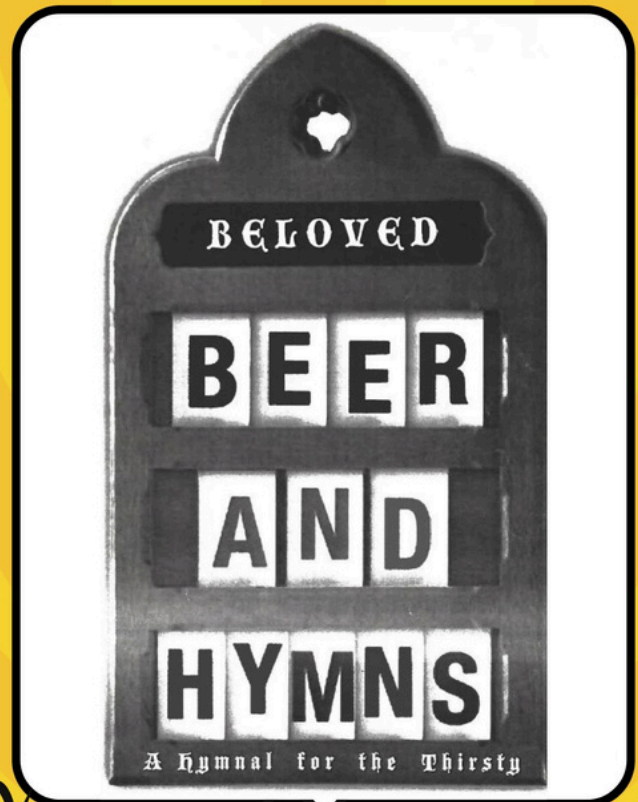
